Setting up a new smart TV has never been more difficult. Every day, smart TVs get smarter - which means there's more for us to figure out. How can you coordinate your set of top box, game console, and various other devices, and why do they want all this personal information just to run the TV? Don't worry, we're here to help, with step-by-step instructions for tweaking your LG TV. From connecting lg remote control to connecting Wi-Fi on an LG TV, we'll go through the process to get your LG smart TV up and running. LG is currently on version 5.0 of its own webOS smart TV software (compared to models that use Google Android TV or Roku software).
